Dear Parents or Guardians:

Fayetteville Public Schools are involved in a process to strengthen the academic and career portions of your student's secondary school experience. It is important to have parents involved in the educational process with their student.

As students begin their selection of classes for grades 7-12, parents are asked to participate in the process. Material related to academic progress, future plans, and graduation requirements needs to be examined and a plan developed in a team approach with the intent that the student sees the connection, aim, and purpose of his/her education. Parents and teachers are vital participants in this endeavor.

Please join us for two nights, the **Pre CAP Parent Info night** and a **CAP night** as your student moves towards his/her future.

1. First of all, please come for a more in-depth explanation of the process at our **Pre-CAP Parent information night on February 20, 2018 at 6:30p.m.** in the Ramay Cafeteria or Woodland Cafeteria (depending on where your child is scheduled to go for the 2018-2019 school year). This night will be dedicated to introducing you to the 7th grade course offerings and an explanation of how you will request your classes.
2. Most importantly, parents are being invited to attend a Career and Academic Planning (CAP) conference with their student and an advisor. During the CAP conference, current sixth graders will request courses for the 2018-2019 school year. There is an option for the CAP conference date of either **March 6th or March 8th for Rising 7th graders.**

Your student will receive a CAP booklet that describes all the classes currently available for 2018-2019 seventh graders. An online version of the CAP booklet will be available on the school websites prior to CAP meetings. Please review this publication prior to your student's CAP conference and arrive at the conference with electives chosen and prepared to review core class recommendations.
